



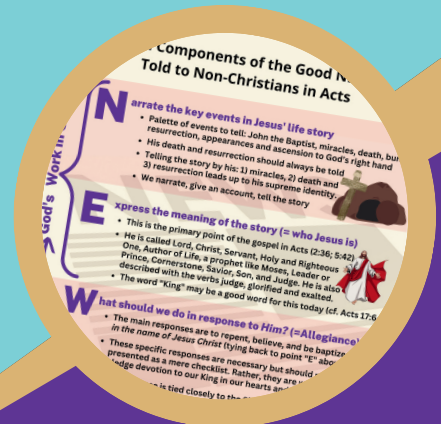
# A GREAT WAY TO TELL THE GOOD NEWS

## How to Get Started Telling the Gospel

Using the NEWS Approach

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### CONFIDENCE

Study and ponder Ten Reasons NEWS is a Great Way to tell the Good News, your notes, and the Acts accounts (fill in your notes) until you feel confident that this is indeed a good way to tell the gospel. Take your time, but don't get bogged down. Continually studying the gospel can lead into thinking about the actual

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### PREPARATION

Make four columns, one for each of the key truths of the NEWS. Then list all the sub-points that go under each one. Use your notes from class, the Acts accounts (listed on 11 in your notes), and the infographic called Main Components of the Good NEWS Told to Non-Christians in Acts. Then organize the sets of sub-points in a way that make sense to you.

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### DECISIONS

Think, pray and review the Acts accounts to decide what order of telling the four key truths makes best sense to you (NEWS, NESW, or other). Next decide and mark which of the sub-points under each truth you believe you should tell people in your initial account of the gospel. You can change your mind later or make more
